

determining the content of alcohol or other drug or drugs, or intoxicating compound or compounds of the person's blood if arrested as evidenced by the issuance of a uniform citation for a violation of the Boat Registration and Safety Act or similar provisions of a local ordinance..." 625 ILCS 45/5-16c(a).

3. Refusal to submit to the required test or tests results in the suspension of the person's driving privileges as outlined in Section 6-208.1 of the Illinois Vehicle Code regarding statutory summary suspensions. 625 ILCS 45/5-16c(e).

4. A person may contest a suspension, such as the one imposed on the Defendant, by requesting an administrative hearing with the Secretary of State in accordance with Section 2-118 of the Illinois Vehicle Code as their sole remedy. 625 ILCS 45/5-16c(e).

5. The Circuit Court of Ogle County does not have jurisdiction to adjudicate a challenge to the suspension of the Defendant's driving privileges based upon his refusal to submit to chemical testing in this matter.

WHEREFORE, the People of the State of Illinois request that the Court enter an order as follows:


A. Striking paragraphs 9-14 of the Defendant's Motion to Dismiss and Other Relief and granting no relief thereon.

B. Granting other further relief as the Court deems equitable and just.
